
Overview

Dispose of explosive substances and/or articles by function as intended procedures in accordance with approved procedures and practices.

You will be required to demonstrate that you can supervise the dispose of explosive substances and/or articles by function as intended procedures in accordance with approved procedures and practices.

This activity is likely to be undertaken by someone whose work role involves Weapons, Ordnance, Munitions or Explosives work activities. This includes people working as disposal managers and supervisors.

Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines
 - P2 ensure that you and those under your control carry out the disposal procedure and the plan correctly
 - P3 carry out all preparatory work and safety precautions
 - P4 take suitable precautions to prevent damage to equipment during disposal
 - P5 segregate and dispose of the residues and products, in accordance with approved procedures
 - P6 maintain documentation in accordance with organizational procedures

Knowledge and understanding

- You need to know and understand:*
- K1 the health, safety and environmental and other statutory legislation, regulations, safe working practices and procedures governing explosives and their implications for your area of work
 - K2 the relevance of personal protective equipment (PPE)
 - K3 the nature, characteristics, hazards and risks of the explosive substances and/or articles to be disposed, and its firing platform
 - K4 the actions to be taken in response to an unplanned event
 - K5 the disposal procedures and the plan
 - K6 procedures for the authorization and use of equipment and location
 - K7 special designated responsibilities
 - K8 environmental controls relating to disposal
 - K9 the reporting documentation to be used
 - K10 the customer's objectives and needs
 - K11 the competences of the personnel involved
 - K12 reporting lines and procedures
 - K13 your own level of authority and of those with whom you work
 - K14 clearance and remedial actions on completion of the disposal
 - K15 how to consign residues and products for disposal
