

Assist in locating the position of the munition

Overview

This standard covers the competences you need to assist in locating the position of the munition in accordance with approved procedures and practices.

You will be required to demonstrate that you can use appropriate equipment and resources effectively, to the recognized standards and manufacturer's instructions confirming that the area has been searched within the stated criteria in accordance with approved procedures and practices.

This activity is likely to be undertaken by someone whose work role involves Weapons, Ordnance, Munitions or Explosives work activities. This includes people working as munition clearance support personnel.

Assist in locating the position of the munition

Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 work safely at all times, complying with relevant health and safety, environmental and other regulations, legislation and guidelines
 - P2 remove any obstacles that might impede the task
 - P3 mark out the area and/or access route, as directed by your instructions, using the appropriate method
 - P4 ensure that the area you mark is accurate to within the prescribed tolerances
 - P5 report any potential problems to the appropriate authority
 - P6 implement protective measures within your area of responsibility
 - P7 pinpoint the position of the munition to such proximity as to enable it to be identified
 - P8 use appropriate equipment and resources effectively, to the recognized standards and manufacturer's instructions
 - P9 mark the location of the munition if required to do so
 - P10 plot the location of the munition to the prescribed accuracy if required to do so
 - P11 confirm that the area has been searched within the stated criteria

Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 the health, safety and environmental and other statutory legislation, regulations and safe working practices and procedures and their implications for your area of work
- K2 the relevance of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- K3 the actions to be taken in response to an unplanned event
- K4 the most appropriate method for marking out the area
- K5 how to interpret information
- K6 what might constitute a problem and in what way it might affect the task
- K7 how to prepare and use the resources and equipment
- K8 your role and responsibility in the task
- K9 the range of likely hazards you may be expected to encounter
- K10 the interaction between suites of equipment
- K11 when and why it may be appropriate to mark and plot the location of munitions
- K12 the stated criteria for searching the area
