

Unload explosive substances and articles from the vehicle

Overview

This standard comprises the following elements:

- 1 Comply with proof-of-delivery requirements
- 2 Assist in the unloading of the vehicle

This activity is likely to be undertaken by someone whose work role involves Weapons, Ordnance, Munitions or Explosives work activities. This includes people working as transport operators.

Unload explosive substances and articles from the vehicle

Performance criteria

You must be able to: 1 Comply with proof-of-delivery requirements

P1 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines

P2 identify the person authorized to receive the load

P3 ensure that the load is delivered according to the documentation

P4 complete all proof-of-delivery documentation once unloading has been completed

P5 communicate in an appropriate manner with the relevant people

P6 identify any problems with obtaining the proof-of-delivery and take appropriate action

2 Assist in the unloading of the vehicle

P7 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines

P8 ensure that you have the correct transport documentation

P9 identify any special requirements for unloading

P10 ensure that the unloading area is suitable and safe for the unloading

P11 ensure that the vehicle is in a suitable position for unloading

P12 ensure that the vehicle is prepared correctly for unloading

P13 identify correctly the part of the load to be unloaded P14 confirm that the unloading has been correctly completed

P15 communicate in an appropriate manner with the relevant people

P16 identify any problems with the unloading and take appropriate action

You need to know and understand: 1 Comply with proof-of-delivery requirements

- K17 the action to take in the event of damaged or suspect loads
